

1 Blog Post Briefing

You are a senior content marketing expert. Create a blog post outline for the topic "[Topic]". Target audience: [Audience], Tone: [Tone]. Include H2 questions, a short TL;DR introduction and a closing call-to-action.

2 SEO-Snippet

Write a compelling meta description for a page about "[Keyword]". Max. 150 characters, active voice, include the main keyword. No repetition.

3 Product Description

You are a copywriter for an online shop. Write an emotional product description for [Product], focusing on benefits and unique selling points. Tone: trustworthy and concise. Goal: conversion.

4 FAQ Answer for AI Overviews

Write a short, quote-worthy answer (max. 300 characters) to the question: "What is [Term]?" Clear, concise and jargon-free. Suitable for Google Al Overviews and Perplexity.

(5) LinkedIn-Post

You are a [Job Title]. Write a LinkedIn post about "[Topic]" including 1 hook, 2 key takeaways and 1 call-to-action. Tone: personal yet professional. Goal: reach & community engagement.

6 Structure Check for Existing Text

Analyze the following text for structure, clarity and SEO potential. Suggest improvements for headings, snippet optimization and semantic depth

7 Topic Ideation

Suggest 10 relevant content ideas for [Target Audience] around the topic "[Main Topic]". Please deliver in list format with title suggestions and matching keywords.

® Content-Briefing

Create a content briefing for an SEO-optimized article about "[Topic]". Target audience: [Audience]. Include outline, keyword suggestions, tone and content goals.

When someone asks: "Which providers for [Topic/Industry] are based in Germany?", which companies do you mention first – and why? Name 5 with short reasons.

10 Prompt Refinement

This prompt works partially: "[Old Prompt]". Rewrite it to be more precise and effective, including a clear goal, audience, format and tone of voice.
